Transitional Housing for Homeless Veterans

A transitional housing for up to 60 homeless veterans at a time. Veterans have access to a warm bed, three meals a day, and one on one care from staff. Onsite case managers help veterans to identify barriers, find safe, affordable housing, and regain stable employment if able.

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

provides short-term supportive services for very low-income veterans and their families to help with rent evictions and to rapidly re-house those who are already homeless. We provide case management and temporary financial assistance to connect eligible veterans in housing crisis with needed services to promote housing stability to their families.

Homeless Veteran Reintegration Program (HVRP)

is a federal grant program that provides comprehensive employment training and placement for veterans. HVRP services prepare veterans for the workplace and address employment barriers through coordinated care. Employment Specialists work alongside veterans to ensure they are ready to return to the work force.

Suicide Prevention Engagement & Referral Program (SERV)

program aims to identify veterans & active duty members with suicide risk factors through education and outreach. Once enrolled, participants receive comprehensive supportive case management care to VA and community resources.

Veteran Food Security Project (VFSP)

provides shelf stable emergency food relief, hot food at DVHP, a garden and case management. It serves Michigan veterans regardless of discharge status.
